


Sources:

- Locations of rare, threatened, and endangered species and significant natural communities were taken from VT ANR Department of Fish and Wildlife, Nongame and Natural Heritage Program's Rare, Threatened and Endangered Species and Significant Natural Communities database. The database is current to February 1997.
- Deer wintering areas delineated by VT ANR, Department of Fish and Wildlife. Digital data released in April 1997 were used.
- Contour lines were generated from USGS 1:24000 Digital Elevation Models by VCGI and edited by WRC.
- Soil boundaries were digitized from 1:20,000 orthophotos from the Windham County Soil Survey.
