Empty and clean #1, #2, some #5 plastics; aluminum & steel, glass bottles/containers, paper, and cardboard can all be recycled
NO Styrofoam or plastic bags

CARDBOARD/PAPER



Cardboard & Boxboard
(Clean & dry)



Junk Mail, Periodicals, & Office Paper
(Paper bags, envelopes, & catalogs)

PLASTIC



Plastic Bottles, Jugs, Tubs, & Lids
(Empty kitchen, laundry, & bath containers & lids/wheels)

METAL



Aluminum & Steel Cans
(For & empty food & beverage cans)

GLASS



Glass Bottles & Jars
(Empty food & beverage bottles & jars)
