Town Plan Listening Sessions



The Westminster Planning Commission is holding listening sessions this fall to collect community input as the Town launches the official Town Plan process. These are opportunities to engage your neighbors and town government, and to help shape the future of Westminster!

A Town Plan in Vermont is a community-driven document that guides future land use, development, conservation, and other strategic priorities for a municipality. It is not a set of enforceable laws by itself, but rather a framework that reflects the shared values, goals, and vision of the town's residents.

At each listening session, members of the Planning Commission will be providing a brief update on the current status of municipal planning in Westminster and feedback we've received so far, before breaking into small groups for conversations on a number of topics, from housing and affordability to conservation and climate resiliency.
